General information for counseling

Candidates will have to be present in the counseling hall half an hour before the time of counseling in respective subjects. Attendance on the date of counseling is mandatory for admission.

- > At the time of counseling, the candidates in the called list should bring the print out of the down loaded application form.
- > Candidates who have not uploaded their photographs should affix his/her passport size recent photograph in the space provided on the downloaded form.
- > Self attested photocopies of all relevant documents are to be attached with the application form.

- Candidates selected after counseling in each subject will have to take admission within 48 hours paying requisite fees via the payment gateway provided on the admission link.
- For any query regarding the merit lists in different Honours subjects please contact Admission Desk at Seminar Hall (2nd Floor) in Main Building of college between 12 Noon to 4 PM for rectification in the list, if any, positively on 23.06.2018 and 25.06.2018, after which no rectification would be entertained.
- ➤ In accordance with the orders of the Honorable Supreme Court, UGC has mandated that all students must submit a student's anti-ragging undertaking and a parent's anti-ragging undertaking to the college at the time of admission. The undertaking can be filled online at www.antiragging.in or www.amanmovement.org. Students are expected to fill-up the affidavit available at the mentioned web-links and present the signed copies of the same at the time of admission failing which the admission process won't be completed.
- For Honours subjects each pair of Generic Electives will have an option A/B depending on which of the two generic electives is chosen in the first year. For example:

Code	Honours	GE1 (year 1)	GE2 (year 2)
ECOA01 A	Economics	Mathematics	Political Science
ECOA01 B	Economics	Political Science	Mathematics

Students will be asked to choose this option at the time of counselling. In case only one of the generic electives is laboratory based subject, irrespective of the choice for the 1st year the fees for the entire course has to be deposited in the 1st year only.

- > All the original documents should be produced at the time of admission.
 - a) Original Mark sheet of the last qualifying Examination, b) Original documents for Caste certificates (for reserved category), c) Physical disability certificate from the appropriate authority (for physically challenged candidates).

Photocopies of all original documents must be submitted at the time of admission.

> All the admissions are PROVISIONAL and the authority reserves the right to cancel any application at the time of verification without showing any reason whatsoever.
