- The college has adopted the policy for reservation of seats earmarked for CU and Non-CU candidates (as per Govt. policy). 60% of the seats are earmarked for Calcutta University (C.U.) candidates only and other 40% of the seats will be filled in through **ADMISSION TEST**. Candidates of any recognized University (including C.U.)can appear in those 40% seats.
- Admission Test will be held for the subjects ZOOLOGY, BOTANY, MATHEMATICS, ENGLISH and BENGALI.
- Multiple choice objectivetype Questions (MCQ) (as per C.U. Hons. Syllabus) will be framed for the admission tests
 in the respective subjects. The Test will be of two hours duration with 50 MCQ questions each question carrying 2
 marks. For wrong answer ofany question, 1/2 mark will be deducted. However for Bengali Subject 80 marks for
 MCQ & 20 marks for writing skill test will be considered.
