<u>Provisional Admission to 1st year Post Graduate Classes in Bengali</u> at Jogamaya Devi College

- Applications are invited for admission to M.A. in Bengali, Session 2017-18, from the **Female Candidates** who have obtained their Bachelor degree with **Honours in Bengali** from University of Calcutta as well as any UGC recognized Indian University.
- Candidates who have obtained their Bachelor degree in 2017 and 2016 are eligible to apply for the said course.

- Application Form will be available from 30.06.2017 to 10.07.2016 (03:00 P.M.).
- Application Fee (Rs.500/-, excluding bank charges) to be paid at the branches of Indian Bank (any Branch) from 30.06.2017 to 10.07.2017 (within Banking hours).
- Reservation of seats as per existing rules of Government of west Bengal. [Reservation of seats for SC (22%), ST (6%), OBC (A-10% & B-7%) and PH candidates are as per rules of Govt. of West Bengal.]
- Merit will be judged on the basis of percentage of marks obtained in Bengali (Hons.)
 Examination. In case of a tie, marks secured in Part II will be taken into consideration.

- Of the total seats, 60% seats will be filled up by the candidates who have passed from the colleges affiliated to the University of Calcutta. Such 60% of total seats be termed as "For C.U. Candidates". All the current year (2017) and preceding year (2016) students passed out as Honours Graduate from C.U. affiliated Colleges will be considered in this category.
- Merit list for this 60% of seats for CU students to be prepared on the basis of percentage of Honours marks at Graduate level.
- Rest 40% of total seats are kept open for both CU Candidates and Non-CU.

For candidates of other Universities:

• In this category, the candidates who have obtained their Bachelor degree in Bengali with Honours from the **University other than Calcutta University** will be considered.
