• Norms for issuance of general admission forms for B.A./ B.Sc. / B.Com for session2015 –2016

B.A. General: Passed 10+2 Examination or its Equivalent Examination in 2012 and onwards& Full marks in English should be 100.

<u>B. Com</u>: Passed 10+2 Examination or its Equivalent Examination in Commerce stream or Science stream (Passed with Mathematics) 2012 and onwards& Full marks in English should be 100.

B.Sc. (Pure General): Passed 10+2 Examination or its Equivalent Examination in Science stream 2012 and onwards & Full marks in English should be 100. Also should be passed in Physics, Mathematics & Chemistry in Theory and Practical separately.

B.sc (Bio General): Passed 10+2 Examination or its Equivalent Examination in Science stream 2012 and onwards & Full marks in English should be 100. Also should be passed in Biology in Theory and Practical separately if the combination is Botany, Zoology & Physiology. If there is Chemistry in combination then candidate should be passed in Chemistry also in Theory and Practical separately.

- Environmental Education/ Studies should not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks.
- For S.C./ S.T. applicant: 40% in the subject or 40% in aggregate by adding the marks in Top Four Subjects in order of marks.
- Norms for issuance of Honours admission forms for B.A. Honourse for session 2015 –2016

Bengali: 45% in Bengali & 200 in Aggregate or 55% marks in Bengali and 30% in Aggregate

English: 45% in English & 200 in Aggregate or 55% marks in English and 30% in Aggregate.

Political Science: 45% in Pol-Science & 200 in Aggregate or 55% marks in Political Science and 30% in Aggregate.

History: 45% in History & 200 in Aggregate or 55% marks in History and 30% in Aggregate.

- Environmental Education/ Studies should not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks.
- For S.C./ S.T. applicant: 40% in the subject or 40% in aggregate by adding the marks in Top Four Subjects in order of marks.
- Applicant should be passed in English having full marks not below 100.
- Norms for issuance of Honours admission forms for B.Sc. Honourse for session 2015 –2016

<u>Physics</u>: 45% in Physics & 200 in Aggregate or 55% marks in Physics and 30% in Aggregate and should be passed in Chemistry & Mathematics (Theory & Practical separately).

<u>Chemistry</u>: 45% in Chemistry& 200 in Aggregate or 55% marks in Chemistry and 30% in Aggregate and should be passed in Physics& Mathematics (Th+Pr separately).

<u>Mathematics</u>: 45% in Mathematics 200 in Aggregate or 55% marks in Mathematics and 30% in Aggregate and should be passed in Physics & Chemistry (Theory & Practical separately).

<u>Computer Science</u>: 45% in Physics/Statistics and Mathematics and 200 in Aggregate/ 55% in Physics/Statistic and Mathematics and 30% in Aggregate , Should be passed in Theory & Practical separately.

Botany: 45% in Biology & 200 in Aggregate or 55% marks in Biology and 30% in Aggregate and should be passed in Chemistry (Theory & Practical separately).

<u>Geography</u>: 45% in Geography & 200 in Aggregate or 55% marks in Geography and 30% in Aggregate should be passed in Theory and Practical separately .

Economics: 45% in Economics / Mathematics& 200 in Aggregate or 55% marks in Economics / Mathematics and should be passed in Mathematics.

- Environmental Education/ Studies should not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks.
- For S.C./ S.T. applicant: 40% in the subject or 40% in aggregate by adding the marks in Top Four Subjects in order of marks.
- Applicant should be passed in English having full marks not below 100.

• Norms for issuance of Honours admission forms for B.Com. Honourse for session 2015 –2016

<u>Accountancy Honours and Marketing Honourse</u>: 45% in Accountancy / Business Economics including Business Mathematics / economics / Statistics / Commerce/ Accounts / Business Statistics / Book Keeping / Business Mathematics / Financial Accounting / Mathematics and 200 in Aggregate.

- Environmental Education/ Studies should not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks.
- For S.C./ S.T. applicant: 40% in the subject or 40% in aggregate by adding the marks in Top Four Subjects in order of marks.
- Applicant should be passed in English having full marks not below 100.
