Advertisement for admissions to the Ph.D. Programme in the Department of Hindi [November 2014]

Applications are invited for admission to the Ph.D Programme in the Department of Hindi. Candidates willing to pursue research work leading subsequently to the Ph.D (Arts) degree in Hindi, University of Calcutta, should apply in the format available in Calcutta University website to the Head of the Department, after paying Rs.100/- to the University cash counter through a challan (duly signed by the HOD) available from the University Cash Counter at the Calcutta University, College Street Campus.

The eligible candidate will have to appear for a written examination to be held in the Department of Hindi, the details of which are appended below. Successful candidates will have to appear for a viva-voce / counselling.

Those candidates who have already passed UGC-CSIR (JRF) NET/SET/SLET/Teacher Fellowship or equivalent examination or passed M.Phil or equivalent examinations need not appear for written test. They can directly appear for the viva-voce / counselling.
