Candidates should have passed B.Sc., B.A., or its equivalent examination with not less than $40 \%$ marks in the aggregate of Part-II (for SC/ST candidates a pass in the qualifying examination is sufficient) and studied the subject(s) mentioned in column(3) of the Table below as optional(s) at the bachelor's degree level.
3. Candidates passing the bachelor's degree examination compartmentally are also eligible provided they secured not less than $40 \%$ marks in the aggregate of Part - II.
