General Rules for Admission in all Stream – 2018-19

Candidates who have passed the **Higher Secondary or equivalent examinations (ISC/ CBSE)** in 2013 and onwards are eligible to seek admission to the 1st year B.A./B.Sc./ B.Com. courses.

- 1. Admission will be strictly on the basis of merit.
- 2. Application forms for admission to the 1^{st} Semester B.A./B.Sc./ B.Com. courses will be available online from 09/06/2018 to 18/06/2018.

5. Candidates belonging to Reserved Categories taking up Honours Course of Study must have obtained a minimum of 40% marks in the aggregate or 40% marks in the subject or related subjects at the previous qualifying examination, as the case may be.

- 6. The college follows the rules regarding reservation of SC, ST and OBC A and OBC B candidates as per the order and notifications issued by Govt. of West Bengal and University of Calcutta, i.e., 22% for SC, 6% for ST, 7 % for OBC A and 3% for OBC B candidates, and also about 3% for PH candidates.
- 7. The candidates are required to read the **general overview for students entering into the CBCS system of study** carefully before filling in the application form.
- 8. The candidates must go through the admission criteria and subject combinations before filling up the admission form.
- 9. The candidates are asked to fill up the application forms carefully. The college authority will not be responsible for any mistake or anomaly in this regard.
- 10. Candidates who have passed from other boards (including distance education) that are not there in the recommended list of eligible boards will not be considered for admission.
- 11. Admission to any course of the college is provisional and subject to approval of the University of Calcutta.
- 12. A candidate must **have secured pass marks in the subjects**/ **allied subjects** which he/she has applied for.
- 13. The aggregate marks are to be calculated on the **basis of best of four subjects** excluding environmental studies.
- 14. The candidates are requested to follow up the admission notice in online or in college notice board time to time during the admission process.

- 3. Proof of date of birth (Attested copy of Madhyamik Admit Card or equivalent examination). Original certificate are to be produced at the time of admission.
- 4. Attested copies of Mark Sheet of Madhyamik and Higher secondary or equivalent examination.
- 5. Attested copy of SC/ST Certificate is to be produced at the time of admission.
- 6. Migration Certificate (in Original) for a migrating student.
- 7. Students getting transferred from other colleges are to produce original Transfer Certificate.
