# Rules for Review of Results For Part-III (General) Examinations, 2016

## A) General Provisions:

A regular candidate having completed the B.A./B.Sc./B.Com Part-III General Examinations of 2016 and having obtained the mark-sheet with Final Status may apply to the Controller of Examinations through the Principal of the concerned college for re-evaluation (review) of his/ her answer-script(s) ordinarily within 15 working days from the date of publication of results subject to the provisions as laid down hereunder. Only those casual candidates who have reappeared in the Part-III General Examinations in 2016 as a whole (in all the General papers) are also eligible to apply for review.

- 1. A candidate may seek re-evaluation of <u>not more than two full papers (100 marks)</u>/half of papers (50 marks).
- 2. Application for re-evaluation shall be <u>restricted to theoretical papers</u> only.
- 3. To be eligible for re-evaluation, <u>a General stream candidate has to secure at least 30% marks in all the remaining General papers/ subjects in Part-III except the paper(s) (max. 2) where he/she is applying for re-evaluation.</u>
- 4. Grace/deficit awards, if any, <u>shall not be taken into account</u> in order to determine the eligibility for re-evaluation.
- 5. Re-evaluation can lead to either <u>an increase in marks</u>, or 'No Change' in marks or a <u>reduction in marks</u>. However, in case of any <u>reduction in marks</u> after re-evaluation, the alteration in marks on re-evaluation shall NOT be given effect if such alteration leads to any <u>deterioration in the overall status of the result</u> of any candidate. (e.g. the result/subject status becomes General to Fail etc.).

### B) Re-evaluation Fees:

Re-evaluation fees is <u>Rs 160 per paper</u>, payable by a candidate at the college, of which <u>Rs 150 per paper</u> is payable to West Bengal State University by the concerned college by means of a Demand Draft drawn on any Nationalized Bank, payable at Barasat or Kolkata, and Rs 10 per paper is to be retained by the college as processing charges.

# C) Submission of Application:

The Review application form may be downloaded from the University website <a href="https://www.wbsubregistration.org">www.wbsubregistration.org</a> and submitted along with the requisite fees to the respective college. (same format is applicable for General and Hons Review). The college shall prepare a CD in Excel format with the details of Review forms (Name, Roll No, Reg. No and papers to be reviewed) and submit the same with the attached format duly filled in along with a Bank Draft for the Fees payable to the University by the stipulated date (mentioned below).

## D) Results of Re-evaluation:

The University shall try its best to publish re-evaluation results for Part-II candidates at the earliest, ordinarily within 45 working days from the closure of receipt of applications (barring unforeseen circumstances).

The last date for submission of applications at the concerned college is 22<sup>nd</sup> July, 2016.

Colleges are requested to send the filled in forms to the University along with a Demand Draft for the requisite fees within 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2016. The date shall not be extended under any circumstances for sake of early publication of Review results in the best interest of students.

# E) Special Review:

A candidate may apply for Special Review of his/her answer scripts (only in Theory papers) as per special provisions of the University. Such applications recommended by the Principal of the concerned college must be made to the office of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor within the above dates. The marks obtained by the candidate in the Selection Tests of Part-III held at the concerned College are to be attached with the application for Special review. **The fees for this service is Rs 1000/- per paper**.
