All candidates who have secured 45% marks in the class 12 examination are eligible to apply for the Hons Courses and all candidates who have passed in class 12 examination are eligible to apply for the Programme Courses. However, for admission in **Economics Hons** and **Nutrition Hons** the student must have passed **Mathematics** and **Chemistry** respectively.

 - Click Admission Form Fillup (right upper corner)
 - Fill-up the application form
 - After filling-up the form click **PROCEED**
 - Click **OK** to submit, or **Cancel** to changes
 - If it is ok then Click **FINAL SUBMIT**, if it is not ok, then click **EDIT FORM** to your application form and edit it duly. (Once you click **FINAL SUBMIT** you cannot edit your application form).
 - You will receive your login ID and password by SMS and E-Mail on your specified cell number and E-Mail ID respectively.
 - Upload scanned copy (**.pdf**) of documents viz. Admit Card of Madhyamik Examination, Marksheet of Madhyamik Examination, Registration Certificate of H.S./Equivalent Examination, Marksheet of H.S./Equivalent Examination, etc.
 - Click **NEXT**
 - Choose **Honours Course** or/and **General Courses**
 - Choose **Honours subjects** (A candidate can choose **maximum 3(Three)** Honours subjects) and click **SUBMIT**
 - The payment page will appear. Pay your registration fee of **Rs 250** by clicking on "pay online"

Log in with username and password (send via SMS) and click **Print Application Form** to take print out of the same.

- 8. Under no circumstances, applicants are allowed to contact the college in person for the admission before commencement of classes. If any applicant has any specific query or finds any mistake in the merit list, s/he is advised to send an e-mail to bccadmission@gmail.com.
- 9. After successful online registration applicants will have to wait for publication of merit list as per the following schedule. - 13. Students after taking provisional admission in a specified subject (both for Programme and Honours course) will be allowed **twice** to change their subject, if their names are found on the subsequent merit lists. Thus, altogether three chances will be given to each candidate.
- 14. Verification of documents will be done only when the classes will commence. If any mistake is found regarding their marks, caste certificate, year of passing H.S. level or any other important information relating to admission, their admission will be cancelled even after the provisional admission. The caste certificates issued by the SDO/BDO will only be considered. Certificate issued on a date after the registration for admission will not be considered.

Before choosing our college for admission please keep in mind that a minimum of 75% attendance in all semesters is compulsory, otherwise the candidate will not be allowed to appear before any college/university level examination.
