Eligibility Criteria

Honours Degree Course

The applicants who have passed the H.S./Equivalent examination (+2 level) either in the year 2021 or 2022 and have secured at least **45%** marks are eligible to apply for online admission to **Honours Courses**.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION TO THE FOLLOWING HONOURS COURSES

i. Electronics Honours & Economics Honours

Applicants who have passed with **Mathematics** at the +2 level are eligible to apply for admission to **Electronics Honours & Economics Honours**.

ii. Nutrition Honours

Applicants who have passed with **Chemistry** at the +2 level are eligible to apply for admission to **Nutrition Honours**.

Programme Course

The applicants who have passed the H.S./Equivalent examination (+2 level) either in the year 2021 or 2022 are eligible to apply for admission to Arts Programme Course and Science Programme Course.

- The applicants who have passed Vocational Engineering and Technology with pass marks in Mathematics equivalent to +2 level examination are eligible to apply for admission to Arts Programme Course and Science Programme Course. Those who have passed without Mathematics or without securing pass marks in Mathematics are eligible to apply for admission to Arts Programme Course.
- Students who have passed Vocational Agriculture equivalent to +2 level examination are eligible to apply for admission to Arts Programme Course and Science Programme Course.

- Students who have passed Vocational Business and Commerce and Vocational Home Science equivalent to +2 level examination are eligible to apply for admission to Arts Programme Course.
- Students who have passed Vocational Home Science equivalent to +2 level are eligible for admission to Arts Programme Course.
- The caste certificates issued by the SDO/BDO will only be considered. Certificate issued on a date after the registration for admission will not be considered.

Merit List Preparation

- Merit list (Score) of the applicants will be prepared based on the total marks of best five (5) subjects in H.S./Equivalent examination. For those who have four (4) subjects, their Merit list (Score) will be prepared by doubling the marks of 1st Language Subject.
- ✓ In case of equal "Score" in H.S./Equivalent examination, percentage of marks of immediately preceding examination will be considered.
- ✓ In respect of calculation of marks, no deduction will be made in case of candidates passing out in previous year.
- ✓ No distinction between the West Bengal Board and Other Boards will be followed while considering marks
