Admission Notice for **SECOND PHASE** of online applications.

Applications are invited for admission to a few vacant seats in several subjects mentioned in the table below, along with their respective eligibility criteria. Interested candidates may apply online directly through the admission portal at gurudascollegeadmissions.com or may reach it through our college website gurudascollege.edu.in. **Applications will be accepted from 19/July/2018, 01:00 P.M. onwards upto 04:00 PM, 26/July/2018.**

All applicants will need to submit an application fee of ₹ 100/- which may be done by using online means (debit/credit card, netbanking, etc.) or by using offline means (manual deposition of the fees + bank charges of ₹ 10/- to any branch of Punjab National Bank during working hours). Online payments will generate an online receipts which the applicants will have to print for themselves whereas applicants opting to pay offline will get an online challan which they will have to print and carry to the bank on the next working day (along with a printout of the application) to make the manual payment.

The merit lists of the second phase for all the subjects will be published online on the admission site on the afternoon of 28th July, 2018. Candidates, in order of merit, will then be invited to take admission according to availability of seats. Notices to this effect will be posted on the college website on or after 28/08/2018.
