- Undergraduate admissions for 2020-21 will be conducted only through the designated admission portal of Lady Brabourne College www.ladybrabourneadmissions.com
- Applicants must register through the above portal before online application. The entire procedures of application and admission are online. There is no provision for offline application or admission.
- Provisional Merit List of the fresh applicants in the above mentioned 6
 B.A. Honours Courses will be published tentatively on 13.10.2020 (after 10 A.M.) on the admission portal.
- Applicants are not required to pay any application fee for the process.
- Only female candidates are eligible to apply.
- Students who have passed the 10+2 level examination in 2020 or 2019 from any recognized board in India (e.g. ISC, CBSE, West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education and other boards of other states) are eligible for application to this college. Foreign students with completely published results of 10+2 level or equivalent examinations are eligible for application.
- Only eligible candidates who have registered on the portal and submitted applications will be considered for admission.
- Candidates can apply 24x7 during the above mentioned period.
