IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Applicants are instructed to read carefully all Admission Schedules published by Lady Brabourne College. All procedures related to UG Admission 2020 will be conducted according to the schedules published.

- Admission will be conducted on the **basis of merit and available vacancies** in a particular UG course.
- Admission process will be conducted as per Government of West Bengal and Calcutta University notifications published from time to time and rules and conventions set by the College.
- Only candidates whose names appear on the **Call Lists** will be eligible for online provisional admission in the respective phases. Call List of one phase will not be valid for other phases.
- The Provisional Merit List scheduled to be published on 06.12.2020 will be on the basis of the applicants who have successfully registered under WISH-LIST 2. Any candidate not registered under WISH-LIST 2 will not be treated as valid.
- It is to be noted that since the **previous Wish-List (Wish-List 1) will be invalidated** hereafter, it is mandatory for **interested candidates, who have already registered under Wish-List 1 but have not yet got call for admission/ secured admission to Lady Brabourne College, to register their names again under Wish-List 2.**
- **All online admissions are provisional and subject to verification of relevant documents.** A candidate's admission is liable to be cancelled on the grounds of violation of rules and regulations laid down the by University of Calcutta and Lady Brabourne College.
- Payment of fees at the time of admission will be fully online.

 - ❖ **For all B.Sc. Honours Courses except Economics : Rs 4106/-**
 - ❖ **For B.Sc. Honours Course in Economics: Rs 3581/-**

 - Candidates shifting from one Honours course to another within Lady Brabourne College should also cancel their previous admission just before proceeding to the next choice.
