NOTICE REGARDING ONLINE APPLICATIONS FOR ADMISSION TO 1st SEMESTER SESSION 2022-2023

- Online applications are invited from students (female) who have qualified 10+2, to take admission in the B.A. / B.SC 1st semester in Malda Women's College affiliated to the University of Gour Banga.
- The college offers **Honours and General Courses** in the following subjects:
1. English 2. Bengali 3. Education 4. Economics 5. Geography 6. History 7. Philosophy 8. Political Science 9. Sociology 10. Sanskrit 11. Women's Studies (only General).
- The college offers admission in **Online Mode only**. No offline applications will be accepted.
- Each application form allows a candidate to apply for **maximum of 4 Honours** subjects and **1 General course**.
- A candidate can choose to apply for Honours and General course together in the **same form** or can apply for either Honours or General course based on their choice but not exceeding a maximum of 4 Honours subject and 1 General course.

1. The schedule of the online admission procedure is as follows: (UGB Circular No. 395/UGB/DR-2022 Date:05.07.2022)

- a. Date of online application begins from: 18.07.2022 (after 10.00 a.m.)
- b. Last date for online application: 05.08.2022 (upto 11.59 p.m.)
- c. Publication of Provisional merit list: 06.08.2022 (after 12.00 p.m.)
- d. Last date for correction of mistakes / errors in Provisional merit list: 08.08.2022 (upto 4.00 p.m.)
- e. Publication of Final merit list (online)-Hons and General : 16.08.2022 (after 10.00 a.m.)
- f. Commencement of different phases of E-counselling, Online Admission & Payment for all Honours courses (1st slot) : 17.08.2022 (after 11.00 a.m.)
(Detailed schedule of e-counseling will be published later)
- g. Commencement of different phases of E-counselling, Online Admission & Payment for all General courses (1st slot) : 22.08.2022 (after 11.00 a.m.)
(Detailed schedule of e-counseling will be published later)
- h. Closing date of entire Online Admission Procedure : 15.09.2022

2. Minimum Eligibility Criteria:

a) Honours Programme: A student who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent Examination from other Boards / Councils with at least four subjects having English as Compulsory Subject of 100 marks is eligible to take admission to the Honours Programmes of Studies of B.A./B.Sc on the basis of merit and available vacancy of the particular subject(s) of the concerned college.

A Student must have passed Geography at the previous examination to take Geography Honours.

b) General Programme: A student who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent Examination from other Boards/Councils with

at least four subjects having English as Compulsory Subject of 100 marks is eligible to take admission to the General Programmes of Studies of B.A./B.Sc. on the basis of merit and available vacancy of the particular subject(s) of the concerned college.

c) A student who has passed Higher Secondary (10+2) examinations (with English as a subject) of the West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education and Skill Development (Erstwhile West Bengal State Council of Vocational Education and Training) or National or State Level Board in regular mode shall be eligible to take admission to the B.A./B.Com General Programme only.

d) Students who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examinations in the current year, immediate previous year and the year before the previous year will only be allowed to take admission.

e) Aggregate marks shall be calculated by adding the marks in English and top-three subjects in order of marks secured by a candidate.

f) The College authorities may fix higher eligibility criteria than the minimum eligibility criteria as laid down in point (a) & point (b).

3. Reservation of seats: There shall be reservation of seats for SC / ST / OBC / Differently-abled Candidates as per Rules of the State Government.

4. Merit Point Calculation:

(a) Subject to the eligibility criteria, the merit lists for the Honours Programme will be prepared as:

(i)
$$(S+T)/4$$

[Where S = Subject marks (opted for Honours Programme) and T = Marks obtained in English + best marks of two other subjects (excluding subject opted for Honours Programme)].

(ii) In case, any candidate opts for an Honours Programme beyond her subject combination

[except linguistic subjects at H.S. (10+2) level], the merit point will be calculated as: $T1/4$.

[Where T1 = Marks obtained in English + best marks of three other subjects (excluding English)].

b) Subject to the eligibility criteria, the merit lists for the General Programme will be prepared as:

$$T1/4$$

[Where T1 = Marks obtained in English + best marks of three other subjects (excluding English)].

1. All the above mentioned dates are provisional and subject to change, if necessary.
