- 2. Admission portal will remain open from 18^{th} July (9 a.m.) to 5^{th} August (9 p.m.), 2022.
 - Complete Merit Panel will be published on 09. 08. 2022. Students securing their position in the First and subsequent merit lists will be informed via SMS.
 - Commencement of Admission on & from 12. 08. 2022

3. Fees For Online Admission Form:

Apply separately in Each Hons. Subject (subject to the fulfilment of admission criteria, a student can apply in more than one Hons. subject) **and separately for General Course.**

For fresh admission in 1st Semester: no charges.

4. Admission Criteria (as per Calcutta University norms CBCS, Semester-wise three-year courses of studies) for the session 2022-2023 are as follows:

Students from WBCHSE, ISC, CBSE, Rabindra Mukta Vidyalaya, N.I.O.S. (declaration needed) are eligible for admission to this College.

Candidates who have **passed the Higher Secondary** (10+2) or its equivalent examination in 2022 and also passed during the years 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021 are eligible to seek admission to the 1st year (1st Semester) of the 3-year (six semesters) B.A./B.Sc (Hons and Gen) Course provided he/she has also passed in English having full marks not being less than 100.

Vocational candidates are eligible to apply only for B.A. General Course.

Additional conditions to be fulfilled: A) FOR B.A / B. SC HONOURS COURSES:
GENERAL CATEGORY

i) A minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate and 45% marks in the subject or related subject* at the previous qualifying examination.

OR

ii) 55% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

OR

iii) 50% marks in the aggregate when the candidate has not studied the subject in his/her previous qualifying examination provided all other clauses are satisfied. *[In case of applicants for B.A. (Hons) in Journalism and Mass Communications course, then related subjects would be English or Bengali]

SC /ST / OBC - A / OBC - B CATEGORY: 40% in aggregate (Best of four; excluding Environmental Studies) or 40% in the subject concerned / related subject.

B) FOR B.A/B. SC GENERAL COURSES: All qualified candidates at plus two examination are eligible to apply for admission.

C) FOR B. COM (HONS. AND GENERAL):

(Semester System has been introduced w.e.f 2017-18 academic session)

A candidate who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent Examination is eligible to seek admission to the 1st year (1st Semester) of the 3-year (6 Semesters) Course of Studies provided he/she has also passed in English having full marks not being less than 100 and fulfils the conditions as laid down in clause 2.

Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Vocational Examination in Business & Commerce conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Vocational Education and Training shall be eligible to seek admission to the B.Com. (General) 1st year Course of Studies under this University. However, no candidate shall be allowed admission after a lapse of more than 5 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.

(**Explanation:** The year of admission shall not be taken into account while calculating five years from the year of passing the previous qualifying Examination).

For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the B.Com. Honours Courses, aggregate marks shall be calculated **by adding the marks in top-four subjects** in order of marks secured by a candidate. However, marks in compulsory Environmental Education/Studies shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks.

However, If the subject "Environmental Science" is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.

- (a) A candidate taking up B.Com. Honours Course in a subject must have obtained:
- i. A minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate and 45% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

OR

ii. 55% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination.

However, candidates belonging to the SC / ST /OBC - A / OBC - B Community taking up Honours Course of Study must have obtained a minimum of 40% marks in the aggregate or 40% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination, as the case may be.

Following subjects be treated as **related subjects for admission** to **B.Com. Honours Courses**:

Accountancy, Business Economics including Business Mathematics, Business Organization, Mathematics, Business Mathematics, Economics, Statistics, Business Studies, Office and Secretarial Practice, Financial Accounting, Elements of Cost Accountancy & Auditing, Book Keeping, Commerce, Cost Accountancy & Principle of Management, Commercial Law and Preliminaries of Auditing, Costing and Taxation.

(b) A candidate shall be allowed to take up B.Com. (General) Course if he/she had passed the subject(s) at the previous qualifying examination as mentioned below:

Accountancy/ Business Economics including Business Mathematics/ Business Organization/Mathematics/ Economics/ Statistics/ Commerce/ Accounts/ Business Studies/ Financial Accounting/Office and Secretarial Practice/ Elements of Cost Accountancy and Auditing/ Book Keeping/ Business Mathematics/ Cost Accountancy & Principle of Management, , Commercial Law and Preliminaries of Auditing, Costing and Taxation.

Students who have **passed the Higher Secondary** (10+2) Examination or its equivalent **from the All India Boards**/Councils (i.e. CBSE, ISC and National **Institute of Open Schooling**) need not require to submit the **Migration** Certificate for getting Registration under this University.

5. Admission To The Honours And General Courses Is Conducted Strictly On The Basis Of Merit.

• The Merit Lists for the Honours and General Courses will be prepared in the following process:

For Honours: Best of Four Marks (excluding ENVS) + Marks in Honours Subject Applied For

For General: Best of four excluding Environmental Studies (ENVS)

6. Merit List Will Be Published According To The Intake Capacity Allowed By The University.

- <u>Candidates who will take admission must have their payment</u> confirmation receipt for future reference.
- 7. There Will Be Provision For Change In The Subject As Mentioned In The Application Form Within The Time Limit Prescribed By University Of Calcutta.
- 8. Special Conditions For Admission To The Following Courses
 - JOURNALISM & MASS COMMUNICATION (HONOURS): Political Science as a Generic Elective (G.E) subject is mandatory.
 - *GEOGRAPHY* (*B. SC HONOURS*): Economics as a Generic Elective (G.E) subject is mandatory.
 - **EDUCATION** (**B.A GENERAL**): If the student has not studied education as a subject in the previous qualifying examination, then Philosophy/Sociology/Economics/Political Science/History are treated as related subjects.
 - Students opting for B.A General courses will have to take 2 (two) subjects, according to their choice, as Core papers and 1 (one) subject as Generic Elective paper. Apart from that they will have to choose between Bengali or English as their AECC 1 (Compulsory) paper for the 1st Semester and Environment Studies (ENVS) as their AECC 2 (Compulsory) paper for the 2nd Semester. Students are directed to fill all these details while applying for the course.
 - For B.A General courses, if a student chooses Bengali (BNGG) or English (ENGG) as their Elective subject, it will automatically become their Core Paper, rather than Generic Elective paper. Also, a student can only choose either English or Bengali as a subject combination for the course.

- For B.A General courses, if a student chooses Political Science (PLSG) as their Core/Generic Elective paper, he / she will not be able Education (EDCG) as their Core / Generic Elective paper and vice versa.
- Students opting for B.A / B. Sc General courses can either take Geography (GEOG) or Journalism (JORG) as their Core or Generic Elective Paper.

Note: The Three year B.A / B. Sc (Honours / General) Programme shall be for a minimum duration of 6 (six) consecutive semesters of 6 (six) months each, i.e., 3 (three) years. The odd semester will start ordinarily in the month of July and the even semester in the month of January of every year.

A candidate pursuing a regular course of study for 3 (three) year semester-wise degree course shall have to clear all the semesters in all respect within a span of 5 (five) years from the year of admission to the particular course and combination, failing which enrolment of the candidate shall stand cancelled.
