

7. RECRUITMENT CENTRES

Candidates whose applications are found correct in all respect will have to undergo the Physical Measurement Test (PMT) and Physical Efficiency Test (PET). Before the PMT/PET, Admit Cards will be uploaded at the Meghalaya Police Website. Admit cards with barcodes and names of candidates for post applied and date and venue of recruitment will be given to the applying candidates. Recruitment shall take place only at 1st Battalion, MLP Mawiong and 2nd Battalion, MLP Goeragre for which candidates will have to indicate their choice in their online application forms. Dates and venue for PET/Written Test/Personal interviews will be duly informed. If candidates appear in the Tests from more than one venue or make an attempt towards that end, his/her candidature will be cancelled forthright for all the venues.

8. ELIGIBILITY

11. PHYSICAL MEASUREMENT TESTS (PMT):

Candidates should download the Admit Card and fix a passport size photograph on the Admit Card with signature and bring along the admit card at the time of appearing for PMT. Candidates who do not meet the standards of Minimum Height Requirement as prescribed will be rejected and further test events of such rejected candidates will not be conducted.

Measurement Test, candidates with admit cards will be required to register themselves at the PET registration counters at the venue of recruitment, for biometric data such as Candidates' Finger Prints/Photo graph. The candidates' biometric profile will be verified before the Physical Efficiency Test. Only candidates successfully verified will be allowed for the Physical Efficiency Test (Race).



(ii) AB/UB Group

5 km race for male and 3 km race for female candidates and Timing Equipment: Each Candidate will be issued with a lockable Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) tag, to be tied to his/her shoulder. The automated timer equipment based on RFID technology will be geared to record start time, finish time and net time of all runners individually. Those who do not finish the race within the minimum prescribed time will be issued a rejection letter and they will not be allowed to participate in other subsequent recruitment events. The 5 KM race for male candidates will have to be completed within 24 minutes and the 3 KM race for female candidates will have to be completed within 19 minutes. This is applicable to all UBSI,

(iii) SF 10 GROUP

10 Km race for SF 10 male and 5.5 Km race for SF10 female candidates and Timing Equipment: Each Candidate will be issued with a lockable Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) tag to be tied to his/her shoulder. The automated timing equipment based on RFID technology will be geared to record start time, finish time and net time of all runners individually. Those who do not finish the race within the minimum prescribed time will be issued a rejection letter and they are not allowed to participate in other subsequent recruitment events. 10 KM race for SF10 ABSI male candidates will have to be completed within 55 minutes and 5.5 KM race for SF10 ABSI female candidates will have to be completed within 34 minutes.10 KM race for SF10 commando male/ Signal Operator male candidates will have to be completed within 50 minutes and 5.5 KM race for SF10 commando female/Signal Operator (female) candidates will have to be completed within 34 minutes.

13. CONDUCT OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION


AB & UB GROUP

- (i) Before the written examination, candidates who qualify in the PET will be given a Final Admit Card which will also be uploaded at the Meghalaya Police Website. Only those candidates who qualify in the Physical Efficiency Test will be allowed to appear at the Written Examination which will be conducted at the time, venue and date to be notified by the Central Recruitment Board. The dates and venues shall be published in local Newspapers and put up on the departmental website.
- (ii) Written examination for UBSI posts shall comprise of 3 papers comprising of (i) General English including Précis Writing, Essay Writing, Drafting and English Grammar (Matriculation standard) of 150 Marks to be completed in 90 minutes, (ii) Elementary Mathematics, Reasoning and Basic Science (Matriculation standard) of 50 Marks to be completed in 30 minutes, and (iii) General Knowledge (based mainly on Meghalaya) of 100 marks. Total= 300 marks to be completed in 60 minutes.
- (iii) Written examination for UB constables post and other UB Posts shall comprise of 3 papers comprising of (i) English Grammar and Usage, (ii) Arithmetic / Elementary Science and (iii) General Knowledge. Each paper shall carry 100 marks Total = 300 marks.
- (iv) Written examination for AB Constables and other AB posts shall consist of one paper only, comprising of Elementary and Basic Knowledge of English, Basic Arithmetic and Basic General Awareness. This paper will be of multiple choice / OMR based Total= 150 marks.

SF 10 GROUP

Written examination for SF10 ABSI posts - shall comprise of 3 papers including of (i) General English including Précis Writing, Essay writing, Drafting and English Grammar (Matriculation standard) of 75 Marks to be completed in 120 minutes, (ii) Elementary Mathematics Reasoning and Basic Science(Matriculation standard) (multiple choice and/OMR based) of 50 Marks to be completed in 60 minutes, and (iii) General Knowledge (based mainly on Meghalaya) 75 marks to be completed in 75 minutes. Total= 200 marks

Written examination for SF10 Commando and other SF10 Posts - shall comprise of 1 paper, Test on Elementary Knowledge of English, Basic Arithmetic and Basic General Awareness. (Multiple choice/OMR based) Total 200 Marks to be completed in 60 minutes.





FOLLOWER GROUP

Trade Test for Followers of SF10/AB/UB:- There shall be no written test for Followers. However, a Trade Test of 150 marks will be conducted on three categories which include (i) Cook (ii) Barber (iii) Sweeper.

14. Medical Test.

The test will be conducted only in respect of candidates who have been selected for various posts as advertised. No fees to be paid by any candidate for medical examination. Medical Standards: Candidates must not have (i) knocked knees, (ii) flat foot or (iii) squint eyed and they should not have (iv) bad eyesight, colour blind, varicose vein or piles where it shall be considered a disqualification. They must be in good mental and bodily health. They must be free from any physical deformities.

15. Test for Specialized Trade.

The Central Recruitment Board will conduct specific trade tests of qualifying nature for the selection of drivers/followers etc. Only those candidates who have come within the qualifying zone as per the merit list will be subjected to these tests.

16. Bonus marks.

The following categories of candidates shall be awarded 5 bonus marks which will be added to their total score: (i) Home Guard Volunteers, (ii) Holders of 'B' or 'C' Certificate of the National Cadet Corps, (iii) Sports persons who have represented the State at the National Level. All claims for bonus marks should be indicated in the application form and supported with copies of documents for such claims should be submitted at the time of PET. Original certificates from the competent authority shall be produced by the candidates claiming bonus marks, to verify the eligibility of candidates to these claims.

17. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- (i) Mobile & Landline Helpline numbers for any clarification will be notified through the Meghalaya Police website <u>megpolice.gov.in</u>.
- (ii) No T.A./D.A. will be admissible to candidates for the journey and stay during any stage of the recruitment.
- (iii)The select lists confers no right to appointment unless the department is satisfied on the suitability of the candidate after a thorough medical examination and such enquiry and verification as may be considered necessary before appointment to the posts.
- (iv)Candidates have to appear in all the stages of recruitment. If a candidate is absent from any stage/event his/her candidature will be cancelled.





- (v) Candidates will be summarily rejected at any stage of the recruitment process for not conforming to the official format/having incomplete information/wrong information/ incomplete requisite certificate/misrepresentation of facts/impersonation.
- (vi) A selected candidate will be required to join and work in any District or Unit anywhere in the State of Meghalaya. The district from where a candidate gets selected will have nothing to do with his/her place of posting.
- (vii)Appointed persons shall be entitled to pension benefits as per the pension scheme existing at the time of appointment.
- (viii)The physical tests are strenuous and candidates who are in proper medical condition only should take the tests. Meghalaya Police will not be liable for any injury or casualty suffered by a candidate during the tests due to any pre-existing medical condition.
- (viii) Fake documents/false information/misrepresentation of facts shall lead to rejection when detected at any stage before or after selection/appointment and shall make the candidate liable to criminal proceeding.
- The final appointment after selection is subject to satisfactory Police Verification (ix) Report and Final Medical Examination Report as per existing norms. In case Police Verification Report of Final Medical Examination Report is found unsatisfactory, the candidature of such candidates will be rejected outright.
- (x) The rules & regulations, terms & conditions of training and afterwards will be applicable as per prevalent Rules of the Government.
- (xi) CANVASSING DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY WILL DISQUALIFY A CANDIDATE AND ANY CANDIDATE FOUND OFFERING BRIBE TO ANYONE INVOLVED IN THE RECRUITMENT PROCESS OR IN A POSITION OF AUTHORITY, SHALL BE DISQUALIFIED AND LIABLE FOR PROSECUTION.
