Admission Procedure :

Rules Regarding Admission :

- i) Application Forms and merit list are available online from college website <http://gurudacollege.edu.in>
- ii) Application for admission should be made in the prescribed admission form.
- iii) Admission in all cases will be conditional on the payment of requisite fees.
- iv) Admission fees must be paid within the date specified, otherwise there is risk of disqualification.
- v) Admission fees etc. must be paid to Indian Overseas Bank, Phoolbagan Branch.
- vi) Forms for registration must be filled in.
- vii) Students from other Boards must submit fees for migration. Migration certificates have to be submitted within one month of admission, in order to be registered.
- viii) **Free Studentship :** Students who wish to avail themselves of free studentship are advised to consult the notice-board for such notification to be issued within three months of admission.
- ix) In addition to scholarships and stipends, free coaching classes are held for S.C./S.T., OBC & Minority category students, in (both) remedial and "Entry in Services" Scheme (UGC sponsored).

Documents required at the time of Admission :

- i) Mark-sheet (original as well as attested photocopy) of last qualifying examination.
- ii) Age-verification certificate (original as well as attested photocopy).
- iii) **SC/ST/OBC/Differently-abled certificate for reserved category candidates (original as well as attested photocopy.)**
- iv) Registration certificate of the H. S. Council.
- v) Two photographs (stamp size).
