## ADMISSION TO B.A./B.Sc. HONOURS PROGRAMME 2021 FOR BOYS ONLY

## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Only online application and online payments are allowed.
2. Filling up of online application form for admission will start from 2 August 2021 at 12 noon. Online filling up of application form for admission will close on 14 August 2021 at 12 midnight.
3. For online form fill up, please visit the college website : www.vidyamandira.ac.in
4. In view of the financial hardship faced by the guardians in the wake of the Covid-19 pandemic, no fees will be charged this year for filling up of Application forms.
5. One may fill up any number of application forms following the eligibility criteria mentioned in the admission norms.
6. Please read the instructions carefully before filling up the form(s).
7. There will be no written test this year. Admission will be based on various criteria determined by the respective departments. While a few departments will conduct online viva voce, other departments will select the students on the basis of the marks obtained by them at the Higher Secondary (+2) and/ or the Secondary level.
8. After initial scrutiny based on the pre-determined parameters, an initial merit list will be prepared and uploaded on the college website. A separate waiting list will also be put up in case of the departments opting out the online viva voce.
9. In case of the departments opting for online viva voce, the candidates making it into the initial merit list will be communicated individually intimating the date and time of the online viva voce, which will be held through 'Google Meet'.
10. Students making it into the list of finally selected candidates will have to appear for an online counseling in 'Google Meet' on the specified date and time. Further, they will have to send scanned copies of requisite documents to us over the email : vidyamandira@gmail.com at least one day prior to the date of online counseling. Absence in online counseling will automatically lead to the rejection of candidature.
11. Selected candidates will have to produce the admit card along with the filled-up online application form during the online counselling.
12. The online counseling may include academic discussion. However, this will have no bearing in the selection process.
13. Selected candidates will have to submit requisite admission fees in online mode immediately after the online counseling.
14. Selected students must bring all the original documents along with the filled-up online form, the online payment receipt (proof of the submission of admission fees) on the day of admission to the hostel. If any student fails to produce any one of these credentials, his candidature is liable to be rejected.
15. Only regular candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary/equivalent examination in 2021 or 2020 will be eligible to apply.
16. Please note that if any candidate fails to fulfill the eligibility criteria as mentioned in our admission notice, his candidature is liable to stand cancelled at any point of the admission process. The college authority will not be responsible for any such cancellation.
17. Waitlisted candidates are required to watch the college website regularly for relevant notification. They may further be required to appear for the second counselling, wherever necessary, the date and time for which will be notified later.
18. If any student fails to appear physically on the day of admission to the hostel, his candidature will automatically be cancelled.

3. The list of selected as well as waiting candidates will be uploaded on the college website.

## Important Notes on the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) :

1. Under the CBCS, a student of any Undergraduate $\mathbf{3}$ year / 6 Semesters Honours Programme is required to take
a) Core Courses (CC) : $\mathbf{1 0 8}$ Credits

- 14 Core Courses (CC) in 6 Semesters as 14 Honours Papers
b) Discipline Specific Elective Courses : $\mathbf{2 4}$ Credits
- 4 Discipline Specific Electives (DSE) courses in the last 2 Semesters ( 2 DSEs in 5th and 2 DSEs in 6th semesters) offered as 4 papers included in his Honours subject.
- Among these 4 DSEs 1 or 2 may be Project work. This will be determined by the Honours Department.
c) Generic Elective Courses (GE): 24 Credits (list of Generic Elective Subjects are given below)
- Within first four Semesters (i.e. within 1st, 2nd 3rd and 4th semester), a student has to opt for 2 Generic Elective (GE) Subjects each of which will have 2 Courses / 2 papers.
- Thus, in each semester a student will have to take one Course / Paper of one Generic Elective Subject only.
- A student will be allowed to select his General Elective Subject 1 in Semester 1 and he will have to continue the same Generic Elective Subject in Semester 2. It means that he will not be able to opt for a new Generic Elective Subject / Course in Semester 2. However, in Semester 3, he will again be allowed to opt for another Generic Elective Subject / Course and this new one will continue in the Semester 4. This means that a student will have to study :
- Course 1 / Paper 1 of Generic Elective Subject 1 in Semester 1,
- Course 2 / Paper 2 of Generic Elective Subject 1 in Semester 2,
- Course 1 /Paper 1 of Generic Elective Subject 2 in Semester 3,
- Course 2 / Paper 2 of Generic Elective Subject 2 in Semester 4.
- However, students should take note of the following conditions before opting for any Generic Elective Subject / Course.
- A student can take any one of the Generic Elective Subject offered by the college as mentioned below except one which he has taken as his Honours subject / course. It means that if a student of Physics Honours Programme intends to opt for Generic Elective Subject / Course in English or Bengali or Philosophy etc., he is allowed to do so, but he will not be allowed to take any Generic Elective Subject / Course from Physics.
- A student must have the prerequisite qualifications as mentioned in the following table (see page 6) to opt for those Generic

Elective Subjects where such prerequisite qualifications are mandatory. If no such prerequisite qualifications are mentioned against any Generic Elective Subject / Course, then it means that any student can opt for that subject.

- A student must consult his mentor-teachers of the Honours Department before opting for any Generic Elective Subject / Course.
d) Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC): 8 Credits
- English Language and Bengali Language / Alternative English :
- 4 Courses means 4 papers
- One English Language Course / Paper and One Bengali Language Course / Paper in Semester 1
- One English Language Course / Paper and One Bengali Language Course / Paper in Semester 2
- Environmental Studies :
- One Environmental Studies Course / Paper in Semester 3
- One Environmental Studies Course / Paper in Semester 4
e) Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC): $\mathbf{8}$ Credits
- Value-Oriented Course
- In all 6 Semesters all students have to study these courses.
- In each Semester one Paper is allotted for this course.

b) In case of a tie in factor (a) above, the candidate with higher marks in Higher Secondary (or equivalent) Bengali (converted to 100) will be preferred.
c) In case of a tie in factors (a) and (b) above, the candidate with higher marks in Secondary (or equivalent) Bengali (converted to 100) will be preferred.
d) The college authorities reserve the right to devise suitable criterion for selection in case of a further tie.
e) The final list of selected candidates will be prepared on the basis of MLT (60) + Viva Voce Score (40) =Grand Total (100)
$>$ Total number of seats in the subject $=12$ (approximately)

## 2. ENGLISH HONOURS:

a) The Merit list will be based on the following criterion : Higher Secondary (or equivalent) English score converted to 100.
b) In case of a tie in factor (a) above, the candidate with the higher aggregate at the Higher Secondary (or equivalent) examination will be preferred.
c) In case of a tie in factors (a) and (b) above, the candidate with the higher marks in English at the Secondary (or equivalent) examination will be preferred.
d) In case of a tie in factors (a), (b), and (c) above, the candidate with the higher Aggregate percentage at the Secondary (or equivalent) examination will be preferred.
e) The college authorities reserve the right to devise suitable criterion for selection in case of a further tie.
$>$ Total number of seats in the subject $=13$ (approximately)

## 3. HISTORY HONOURS :

a) The Merit list will be based on the Higher Secondary (or equivalent) aggregate marks converted to 100 .
b) In case of a tie in factor (a) above, the candidate with the higher Aggregate percentage at the Secondary (or equivalent) examination will be preferred.
c) In case of a tie in factors (a) and (b) above, the candidate with the higher marks in Aggregate percentage at the Higher Secondary (or equivalent) Language group will be preferred.
d) The college authorities reserve the right to devise suitable criterion for selection in case of a further tie.
e) The final list of selected candidates will be prepared on the basis of H.S. Aggregate converted to 50 + Viva Voce Score 50 =Grand Total 100.
$>$ Total number of seats in the subject $=13$ (approximately)

## 4. PHILOSOPHY HONOURS:

a) The Merit list will be based on the Higher Secondary (or equivalent) Aggregate converted to 100
b) In case of a tie in factors (a) above, the candidate with the higher percentage of marks in Secondary (or equivalent) Aggregate will be preferred.
c) The college authorities reserve the right to devise suitable criterion for selection in case of a further tie.
d) The final list of selected candidates will be prepared solely on the basis of Viva Voce Score (30)
$>$ Total number of seats in the subject $=13$ (approximately)

## 5. POLITICAL SCIENCE HONOURS :

a) The Merit list will be based on the Higher Secondary (or equivalent) Aggregate converted to 100 .
b) In case of a tie in factor (a) above, the candidate with the higher percentage of marks in Higher Secondary (or equivalent) Language group will be preferred.
c) The college authorities reserve the right to devise suitable criterion for selection in case of a further tie.
$>$ Total number of seats in the subject $=13$ (approximately)

## 6. SANSKRIT HONOURS :

a) The Merit list will be based on the Higher Secondary (or equivalent) Aggregate converted to 100 .
b) In case of a tie in factor (a) above, the candidate with the higher percentage of marks in Higher Secondary (or equivalent) Sanskrit will be preferred.
c) The college authorities reserve the right to devise suitable criterion for selection in case of a further tie.
d) The final list of selected candidates will be prepared solely on the basis of Viva Voce Score (50)

## 7. CHEMISTRY HONOURS :

a) The Initial Merit list will be prepared on the basis of the following criteria : Secondary (or equivalent) Aggregate marks converted to 70 + Secondary (or equivalent) (Physics + Chemistry + Mathematics) or (Physical Science + Mathematics) marks converted to 20 + Higher Secondary (or equivalent) Aggregate marks converted to $\mathbf{1 0}=$ Merit List Total (MLT) 100
b) In case of a tie in factor (a) above, the candidate with higher marks in Secondary (or equivalent) (Physics + Chemistry + Mathematics) or (Physical Science + Mathematics) (converted to 20) will be preferred.
c) In case of a tie in factors (a) and (b) above, the candidate with higher marks in Secondary (or equivalent) Aggregate (converted to 100) will be preferred.
d) In case of a tie in factor (a), (b) and (c) above, the candidate with higher marks in Higher Secondary (or equivalent) Aggregate (converted to 100) will be preferred.
e) The college authorities reserve the right to devise suitable criterion for selection in case of a further tie.
f) The final list of selected candidates will be prepared on the basis of MLT (100) + Viva Voce Score (20) =Grand Total (120)
$>$ Total number of seats in the subject $=24$ (approximately)

## 8. COMPUTER SCIENCE HONOURS :

a) The Merit list will be prepared on the basis of the following criterion : Higher
secondary (or equivalent) aggregate (converted to 15) + total marks obtained in Higher secondary (or equivalent) Mathematics and Max (Physics, Computer Science/Application) converted to $25+$ Secondary (or equivalent) aggregate converted to 20 + Marks obtained in Secondary Mathematics and Max (Physical Sc, Computer Sc/Applications) converted to $40=$ Merit List Total (MLT) 100.
b) In case of a tie in factor (a) above, the candidate with a higher marks in Max (Mathematics, Computer Science/ Applications) will be preferred
c) In case of a tie in factors (a) and (b) above, the candidate with higher marks in Higher Secondary (or equivalent) Mathematics will be preferred.
d) The college authorities reserve the right to devise suitable criterion for selection in case of a further tie.
e) The final list of selected candidates will be prepared solely on the basis of Viva Voce Score (25).
$>$ Total number of seats in the subject $=14$ (approximately)

## 9. ECONOMICS HONOURS:

a) The Merit list will be based on the following composite score : Higher Secondary (or equivalent) Aggregate converted to 50 + Higher Secondary (or equivalent) Mathematics converted to $\mathbf{5 0}=$ Total 100
b) In case of a tie in factor (a) above, the candidate with the higher score in Higher Secondary (or equivalent) Mathematics (converted to 100) will be preferred.
c) In case of a tie in factors (a) and (b) above, the candidate with the higher marks in English at the Higher Secondary (or equivalent) examination (converted to 100) will be preferred.
d) The college authorities reserve the right to devise suitable criterion for selection in case of a further tie.
$>$ Total number of seats in the subject $=13$ (approximately)

## 10. INDUSTRIAL CHEMISTRY HONOURS:

a) The Merit list will be based on the following composite score : Higher Secondary (or equivalent) Aggregate converted to $50+$ Secondary (or equivalent) Aggregate converted to 25 + Secondary (or equivalent) (Physics + Chemistry)/ Physical Science converted to 25 = Merit List Total (MLT) 100
b) In case of a tie in factor (a) above, the candidate with the higher marks in Secondary (or equivalent) Mathematics (converted to 100) will be preferred.
c) In case of a tie in factors (a) and (b) above, the candidate with the higher marks in Secondary (or equivalent) (Physics + Chemistry)/ Physical Science (converted to 100) will be preferred.
d) The college authorities reserve the right to devise suitable criterion for selection in case of a further tie.
e) The final list of selected candidates will be prepared on the basis of MLT (100) + Viva Voce Score (40) =Grand Total (140)
$>$ Total number of seats in the subject $=18$ (approximately)

## 11. MATHEMATICS HONOURS:

a) The Initial Merit list is to be formed based on the following composite score : Marks obtained in Secondary (or equivalent) Mathematics converted to 30 (A) + Marks obtained in Higher Secondary (or equivalent) Mathematics converted to $10(B)+\mathbf{1 0}$ marks for successful qualification of any one of the competitions on Mathematics held on or after 1st January 2017 (C) = Total 50

a) The Merit list will be based on the following composite score : Secondary (or equivalent) Biology/Life Science converted to 25 + Secondary (or equivalent) (Physics + Chemistry)/Physical Science converted to 25 + Secondary (or equivalent) Aggregate converted to $30=$ Merit List Total (MLT) 80
b) In case of a tie in factor (a) above, the candidate with the higher marks in Secondary (or equivalent) Life Science will be preferred.
c) In case of a tie in factors (a) and (b) above, the candidate with the higher percentage of marks in Secondary (or equivalent) (Physics + Chemistry)/Physical Science will be preferred.
