$\mathbf{5 5 \%}$ marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination, Or $\mathbf{5 0 \%}$ marks in the aggregate when the candidate has not studied the subject in his/her previous qualifying examination provided all other clauses are satisfied, And

Candidates belonging to Reserved Categories taking up Honours Course of Study must have obtained a minimum of $40 \%$ marks in the aggregate or $40 \%$ marks in the subject or related subjects at the previous qualifying examination, as the case may be. And

Must have passed separately in both theory and practical in the subject or related subjects at the previous qualifying examination. and

Must have passed in subjects (at the previous qualifying examination) which he/she is intending to take as Generic Elective Subjects,
