4.	B.Sc. General with Geography	40% Marks in aggregate and 45% marks in Geography. Must have passed in all taken subjects (Both theory and practical) at previous qualifying examination.	25

Education: If the candidate has not studied Education as subject in the previous qualifying examination then Psychology/Philosophy/ Mathematics/ Sociology/ Economics/ Political Science/ History/ statistics/ Chemistry/ Biology are treated as related subjects.

Philosophy- If the candidate has not studied Philosophy as subject in the previous qualifying examination then Psychology/Mathematics/ Education/ Sociology/ Political Science are treated as related subjects.

Computer Science - If the candidate has not studied Computer Science as subject in the previous qualifying examination then Mathematics & any one of Physics/ Statistics/ Electronics are treated as related subjects.

**** Minimum Criteria for Honours Admission 2019-20**

A minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate and 45% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination. *Or*

55% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination, *Or*

50% marks in the aggregate when the candidate has not studied the subject in his/her previous qualifying examination provided all other clauses are satisfied, *And*

Candidates belonging to **Reserved Categories taking up Honours Course** of Study must have obtained a minimum of 40% marks in the aggregate or 40% marks in the subject or related subjects at the previous qualifying examination, as the case may be. *And*

Must have passed separately in both theory and practical in the subject or related subjects at the previous qualifying examination. *and*

Must have passed in subjects (at the previous qualifying examination) which he/she is intending to take as **Generic Elective Subjects**,
