

# Modalities of final Year/Semester Examinations 2019-20 at UG and PG levels

Resolution of the online Syndicate meeting of Calcutta University held on July 2, 2020 at 2 pm.

Resolved that following modalities have been approved for the final Year/Semester Examinations at the UG and PG levels for the academic session 2019-20

## UG BA/B.Sc. Part III (1+1+1) and B.Com Part III Old (1+1+1):

Resolved that for the preparation and publication of results of above mentioned final examinations, 80% of the marks will be awarded from the best aggregate percentage of the previous two years' marks and remaining 20% marks will be awarded from the internal assessment taken from test examination results which will be sent by the corresponding colleges (paper wise and course wise) within July 10, 2020. These marks will be posted on the University website after the result is published. The answer scripts should be preserved in the colleges and have to be sent to the University as and when required.

Regarding 'back' papers the marks will be awarded on the basis of the best score obtained in the remaining qualified papers of that year.

#### UG (B.Com., CBCS):

Resolved that for the preparation and publication of results of above mentioned final examinations, 80% of the marks will be awarded from the best aggregate percentage of previous five semesters' marks and remaining 20% marks will be awarded from the best of previous semesters internal assessments.

Regarding 'back' papers the marks will be awarded on the basis of the best score obtained in the remaining qualified papers of that semester.

#### PG:

Resolved that for the preparation and publication of results of above mentioned final examinations, 80% of the marks will be awarded from the best aggregate percentage of previous three semesters' marks and remaining 20% marks will be awarded on the basis of internal assessment which will be decided by the corresponding Department through DC/FC (paper wise and course wise) and to be sent by the Head of the Department to the Controller of Examinations within July 10, 2020.

Regarding 'back' papers the marks will be awarded on the basis of the best score obtained in the remaining qualified papers of that semester.

#### **PG Diploma:**

Resolved that for the preparation and publication of results of above mentioned final examinations, 100% of the marks of the previous semester and actual marks obtained in the internal assessment (Project and Viva) to be awarded.

Regarding 'back' papers the marks will be awarded on the basis of the best score obtained in the remaining qualified papers of that semester.

### Professional courses (like Engineering and Technology, Management, Law etc):

80% of the marks will be awarded on the basis of internal assessment/mid semester examination/ best of the aggregates of previous semesters and remaining 20% will be awarded from the assignment based evaluation.

Regarding 'back' papers the marks will be awarded on the basis of the best score obtained in the remaining qualified papers of that semester.

It has further been approved that if a student wishes to appear in a formal examination instead of alternate evaluation method, as stated above, he / she should be given an opportunity to apply for the same through a process to be notified by the university. However, the said examination should be conducted only after the situation gets normalized and the result of the said special examination may be published within one month of the examination being held. The final result marks should be revised as per the student's performance in the special examination, irrespective of whether he/she secures more or less marks than what is awarded to him/her through alternate evaluation method. To this effect, an undertaking may be obtained from the student before allowing him/her to appear in the special examination.
