Regulations relating to Admission and Examinations for the Eight semesters Bachelor of Fashion and Apparel Design (B.F.A.D).-Honours Degree and Six semesters Bachelor of Fashion and Apparel Design General (IDC) Degree Course of Study under Curriculum and Credit Frame Work, 22 as per NEP-20, Under the University of Calcutta

- ✓ In exercise of the powers conferred by Section-54 of The Calcutta University Act 1979, the University of Calcutta hereby makes the following Regulations for eight semester **based B.F.A.D.(Honours) and six semester B.F.A.D General (IDC)Course, 2023.**
- ✓ These shall apply to every candidate prosecuting the above said Course of study in this University.
- ✓ Notwithstanding anything contained in any other regulations or rules for the time being in force the study for the above said Course shall be guided by these Regulations effective from the Academic Session 2023-2024.

1. Title and Commencement

- 1.1 These Regulations shall be called **THE REGULATIONS FOR SEMESTERWISE 4yearB.F.A.D.(Honours) DEGREE PROGRAMME and 3 year B.F.A.D General (IDC) Programme UNDER Curriculum and Credit Frame Work, 22, conducted by UNIVERSITY OF CALCUTTA.**
- 1.2 These Regulations shall come into force with effect from the academic session 2023-2024.

2. Duration of the Programme

- 2.1 The 4-year B.F.A.D.(Honours) Programme shall be for a minimum duration of **eight (08) consecutive semesters of six months each, i.e., four (4) years** and will start ordinarily in the month of **July** of each year and the even semester in the month of January every year.
- 2.2 The **3 year B.F.A.D General (IDC) Programme** shall be for a minimum duration of **six (06) consecutive semesters of six months each, i.e., three (3) years** and will start ordinarily in the month of **July** of each year and the even semester in the month of January every year.
- 2.3 All student prosecuting a regular course of study for semester wise degree course shall have to clear all semesters in all respect within a span of seven years from the year of admission to the particular course and combination for 4-year B.F.A.D.(Honours) Programme, failing which enrolment of the student shall stand cancelled.
- 2.4 All student prosecuting a regular course of study for semester wise degree course shall have to clear all semesters in all respect within a span of six years from the year of admission to the particular course and combination for 3 year **B.F.A.D General (IDC) Programme**, failing which enrolment of the student shall stand cancelled.

3. Applicability of the Regulations:

These regulations shall be applicable to:

a) The students taking admission to the B.F.A.D.(Honours) Course and BFAD General (IDC) Course from the academic session 2023-2024.

b) Students who have already successfully completed U.G. degree earlier are not eligible to take admission in the above course. However, this is not applicable for sponsored candidates.

c) The students admitted in earlier sessions and appeared in B.F.A.D.(Honours) semester wise examinations in 2022 or earlier shall continue to be guided by the existing Regulations of CBCS based 6 semester of B.F.A.D. Honours degree course under existing old syllabus and regulations prevailing from 2018-19 session.

I-Admission Regulations

4.(a) (i) A candidate who has passed the Higher Secondary examination or equivalent examination in any stream/ combination from recognised Board of Examination or its equivalent Examination is eligible to seek admission to the 1st semester of the eight semesters (4-year) B.F.A.D.(Honours) Course of Studies under CCF, 22, based course in this discipline with at least 45% marks in aggregate for general category students and at least 40% in aggregate for SC/ST students.

(ii) Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Vocational examination conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Vocational Education and Training shall be eligible to seek admission in 1st Semester of B.F.A.D.(Honours) Course of Studies.

(iii) Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary examination or equivalent examination from recognized open school shall be eligible to seek admission in 1st Semester B.F.A.D.(Honours) Course of Studies.

(iv) Candidates who have passed 3 year Diploma (without Higher Secondary Examination) from State Council recognised Diploma in Handlooms/ Textiles/Garment /fashion Technology/ Design or Diploma in any other relevant field or equivalent shall be also eligible to seek admission in 1st Semester B.F.A.D.(Honours) Course of Studies.

However, no candidate shall be allowed admission after a lapse of more than 5 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.

(Explanation: The year of admission shall not be taken into account while calculating five years from the year of passing the previous qualifying Examination). However, this restriction is not applicable for admission of sponsored students.

(b) Students who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination or its equivalent from the All India Boards/Councils (i.e. CBSE, ISC and National Institute of Open Schooling or State Council recognised 3 year Diploma in relevant field) need not require to submit Migration Certificate for getting Registration under this University.

(c) However there will be only one lateral Entry Option in the 2nd year that is 3rd Semester of this course for candidates completing 1 year (1st and 2nd semester) course in specific other relevant subjects like Bachelors of Fine Arts, Journalism & Mass Communication, Communicative English, B.Sc. in Textile Clothing / Fashion or any other equivalent Course judged by the competent authority of the University.

5. For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the B.F.A.D.(Honours) Courses, aggregate marks shall be calculated by adding the marks in top-four subjects in order of marks secured by a candidate. However, marks in compulsory Environmental Education/Studies shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks. However, if the subject "Environmental Science" is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.

6. (a) A candidate taking up Honours Course in the subject must have obtained:

- i) A minimum of 45% marks in the aggregate in the higher secondary or equivalent qualification at the previous qualifying examination for General category candidates
- (ii) However, candidates belonging to the Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe Category taking up BFAD Honours Course of Study must have obtained a minimum of 40% marks in the aggregate at the previous qualifying examination Higher Secondary or equivalent, as the case may be.

(b) There will be ordinarily total provision of seats for admission of 38 students (21 General, 8 SC, 2ST, 4OBC-A,3 OBC-B) and 10 sponsored candidates, altogether 48 seats. However, PWD seats and seats of EWS will be as per Government rule application in the state of West Bengal as ratified by C.U. from time to time.

(c) Seat reservation for admission in four year (eight semesters) B.F.A.D. (Honours) degree courses of studies shall be guided by the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission), Act, 2013 and the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Rules, 2014 and Memorandum number 339 –Edn(CS)/OM-74L/2023, dt. 26.05.2023 and as amended from time to time there in.

(d) The course fee for admission to this BFAD(Hons) course for General/ SC/ST/ OBC-A and OBC-B will be as per previous CSR/decision of the University of Calcutta or as amended from time to time.

7. Attendance

7.1 A student attending at least 75% of the total number of classes* held shall be allowed to appear at the concerned Semester Examinations subject to fulfillment of other conditions laid down in the regulations.

7.2 A student attending at least 60% but less than 75% of the total number of classes* held shall be allowed to appear at the concerned Semester Examinations subject to the payment of prescribed condonation fees and fulfillment of other conditions laid down in the general rules for B.A./B.Sc. candidates under C.U..

7.3 A student attending less than 60% of the total number of classes* held shall not be allowed to appear at the concerned Semester Examinations and he /she has to pursue admission to the same Semester in the very next year for attending the classes and also for appearing at the said Semester Examination.

*Such attendance will be calculated from the date of commencement of classes or date of admission, whichever is later.

Explanation: A student who has not been able to appear at any semester end-examination in terms of Clause 6.3 may take admission to the next higher Semester and appear at such higher Semester end Examinations. However, such student has to take admission to the concerned Semester, for which the candidate has been eligible under Clause 6.3, in the very next available chance without pursuing any other Semester Course simultaneously.

8. TEACHING –LEARNING PROCESS

- a) There should be minimum 6 teachers, besides 3 technical staffs and required number of visiting Faculty will be required to complete this courses successfully.
- b) As this is a course on design based textiles and apparels, specialist/ expert designers/ artisans and relevant industry experts having more than 10 years experience may be invited to take fewer or number of required classes or exams irrespective of having Master.s degree as their qualifications in relevant field or not.
- c) Required number of classrooms or laboratories will be required to be built up gradually for conducting practical classes and projects.
- d) For Special and Modern equipments and production Machinery/ design creation centre/ Cluster etc the Faculty members may organise visits for all students to outside Institutes/ organisations and industry for practical demonstration of those high end/ outreach facilities.
- e) Practical training for one week may also be organised in reputed University/ Institutes for students for in hand learning of processing and testing of textiles and garments.

II-EXAMINATION REGULATIONS

9.1. The 4year B.F.A.D. (Honours) degree Course of Studies under CCF,22 shall consist of eight (08) Semesters (Semester-I, Semester-II, Semester-III, Semester-IV, Semester-V, Semester-VI, Semester-VII, Semester-VIII) and the 3year B.F.A.D. General (IDC) degree Course of Studies under CCF,22 shall consist of SIX (06) Semesters (Semester-I, Semester-II, Semester-III, Semester-IV, Semester-V, Semester-VI).

9.1.1. End Semester Examinations are to be held ordinarily at the end of the concerned Semester, i.e., Semester-I, Semester-III, Semester-V and Semester-VII in **December-January** and Semester-II, Semester-IV, Semester-VI and Semester-VIII in **June-July of every year.**

9.1.2. End Semester Examinations of each paper will be held for **40 marks as university exam + 10 marks for Internal Assessment/For Assignment and file work.**

9.2.1. Paper setters, moderators, exam-coordinators / external examiners, internal examiners, scrutinizers and reviewers for each paper will be appointed by the University Authorities on the recommendations of the Under Graduate Board of Studies in that discipline.

9.2.2. Answer scripts are to be examined by a single examiner for all theory papers

9.2.3 Supplementary Examination

Any candidate failing to earn 12 credit out of maximum 24 credit will be allowed continue classes in the next semester and allowing him/her to appear in the supplementary examination in the next year in the same semester to pass those papers in which he / she failed to obtain his / her credit of that semester.

A candidate may be allowed for supplementary examination in the papers he/ she has failed if it does not exceed 50% of the total credit of that semester and may be allowed to continue the next semester.

However a candidate securing less than 50% credit of that semester will be considered as totally fail in that semester and will not be allowed to continue studies in next semester and in that case a candidate may take readmission in that semester with payment of all fees as usual and has to appear in all the papers of the semester as a fresh candidate of that semester.

9.2.4 Special Supplementary Examination:

For 7th & 8th Semester awarding B.F.A.D. Honours Degree, and for 5th & 6th semester for awarding B.F.A.D. (General IDC) Degree, special supplementary may be arranged for final two semester students, to appear in special supplementary examination within three months from the date of result publication to pass those papers, provided he or she has not utilized maximum three chances to pass those papers or completed total 7 years of studies. The responsibilities of arranging special supplementary exam timely lies on the corresponding Department / college / University authority.

9.3. End Semester Examinations Duration:

9.4 Role of Board of Studies/ Board of Expert in BFAD(Hons) Degree Course

The BOS/BOE in BFAD (Hons) Degree Course will recommend the names of paper setter, examiner, moderators and suggest names of internal and external examiners for all semesters. For any change of examination programme or for any change of any examiner for any reason has to be recommended by Chairman, BOS to the Controller of Examinations, CU., for necessary action..

9.4.1 Special provisions are to be made for appointing external examiners for all practical papers/ internship/dissertation/ portfolio/ seminar etc as external jury for conducting examinations of practical papers of portfolio, project, seminar etc. as recommended by BOS. University will arrange to pay the local travel cost and honourarium for the external

examiners and jury members as per rules of C.U after certification/ forwarding the bill of travel and honourarium for such external examiner, be sent timely to C.U..

9.4.2 Question papers shall be set in English for the B.F.A.D. Honours and B.FAD General (IDC) course of study, after moderation by Board of Moderators

9.5. Medium of Answer

For examinations of different papers candidates shall have to write their answers in English in all the theory and practical components of each paper.

9.6. University Examination shall be held always following the detailed current syllabus of this course of BFAD(Hons) and BFAD General (IDC) course subject to as and when amended by the University Authority .

10. For conducting university exam of each semester the relevant affiliated College/Institution, who shall inturn submit those student exam application forms in prescribed format duly filled in by the candidates intending to appear at the said examination(s) to the Controller of Examinations after necessary endorsement from Head of the Institution/ College/ In-charge of that course within the last date fixed by the University with payment of necessary exam fee, as prescribed by the Calcutta University. Fee for examination form fill up of this course for each semester will be Rs 1500/- per candidate, Rs 600 for theoretical papers and Rs 900/- practical subjects.

However, this exam fee structure may be amended by C.U. from time to time.

Issue of admit card will be governed by existing rules and systems of C.U.

11. A candidate pursuing the said B.F.A.D.(Honours) and BFAD General (IDC) Course of Study will have to follow the following details of pass marks for each paper of 50/100 marks for all the theory and practical papers therein:-

Pass Marks : For 1st Year , 2nd Year & 3rd Year that is 1-6 semester of BFAD (Honours) or BFAD General (IDC) degree course in each paper the general pass marks will be 30% individually in each of the Theory and Practical paper. However pass marks for 7th and 8th semester research based or non- research BFAD Hons candidates will be 40% in each theory and practical paper individually.

However, candidates obtaining less than 50% in total aggregate for 1 to 6th semester marks awarded, but passing in all theory and practical papers individually will not be allowed to continue BFAD Honours degree course and will not be allowed to proceed to 7th and 8th semester and they have to obtain the BFAD General (IDC) degree course after 6th semester (without Honours) to exit .

12.1. In order to get the B.F.A.D. Degree (Honours with research) a candidate shall have to earn 75% Of marks in the aggregate of total 1st to 6 semesters and for obtaining B.F.A.D. Degree (Honours without research- Non-research) has to earn atleast 50% or above. However, any candidate securing 75% in aggregate for 1st to 6th semester in total, optionally may opt for Non research B.F.A.D. (Honours) Degree also.

12.2 A candidate who is eligible to appear at any of the End Semester Examinations but does not enroll or does not appear at the examinations or fails to secure pass marks in the paper(s) at the concerned examinations, will also be allowed to appear in that failed semester examination along with next semester batches as applicable and the candidate is eligible to attend the next higher semester classes and also to appear in university end semester exam within the limit of 6 semesters.

12.3 A candidate may appear at any higher End Semester examination without appearing at lower End Semester Examinations.

12.4. A candidate who fails to secure pass marks in one or more papers of a semester may appear in those paper(s) when the concerned End Semester Examinations which will be held in next batches.

12.5 However, for the end two semesters for BFAD(Hons) degree course, i.e. 7th and 8th Semester of BFAD Honours degree course and 5th and 6th semester for BFAD General (IDC) course, if a candidate fails in any paper shall get an opportunity to clear those papers in **special supplementary examination** to be arranged within 3 months from the date of result publication of 5th and 6th semester for BFAD General (IDC) course or result publication of 7th and 8th semester for BFAD Honours degree course, to be held specially for those candidates to give them chances to complete their course of study getting maximum three chances to pass a paper, so that candidate need not to wait for next 5th and 6th semester regular examination for BFAD General (IDC) course and for 7th or 8th semester regular examination of BFAD Honours degree course. This is applicable only at the last two semesters within the rules and purview of maximum 7yrs of total duration allowable for a candidate to pass the said 4 yr (8 semester) BFAD course and within the purview of maximum 6years for total duration for 3year(six semester) BFAD General (IDC) degree course .

13. Review/ Re-examination:

i) Review/ Re-Examination is applicable only for Theoretical papers of different end semester examinations of 4-year B.F.A.D. Honours Course of Study and 3year BFAD General (IDC) course of study. Re-examination/ review is not permissible for Internal Assessment, Practical Examinations and Project Work/ Term paper or In-plant Training, Internship and field visit, portfolio etc.

ii) A candidate will not be eligible to review/ re-examine his/her answer script if he/she appears at the concerned Semester examination for supplementary Examination.

iii) A student shall be allowed to apply for re-examination /review of not more than 50% of total credit of theoretical papers/ module in each semester for BFAD Honours degree or BFAD general degree courses provided that he/she has scored qualifying marks, i.e.,30% in the remaining papers of that Semester and in aggregate he/ she has secured at least 50% credit earned.

iv) In re-view/ re-examination of papers for any end Semester Examinations of 4-year B.F.A.D. Honours Course and BFAD General (IDC) course, the marks awarded by the re-examiner in a paper will be taken as the final marks obtained by the candidate in that paper. If on re-examination of a paper, the marks get enhanced by more than 15% or get reduced by more than 5% than that awarded by the original first examiner (the percentage is to be calculated on the basis of the full marks in that paper), the script of the paper shall be referred to a third examiner. In such cases, among the marks awarded by three examiners, i.e., original first examiner, second examiner (re-examiner) and the third examiner, the average of the closer two marks will be awarded, provided that such a final award does not result in lowering of the **grade point** obtained by the candidate prior to re-examination in which cases the original award is to be retained.

V) Scrutiny and Review

Any candidate if not satisfied with the marks obtained in any paper may apply for either scrutiny or review or both filling up the prescribed form obtained from University paying requisite fee for maximum 50% of the total credit of that semester provided the candidate secured at least 50% of the total credit of that semester.

14. Grace Marks

14.1. A candidate who fails to obtain pass mark in any paper(s) in any semester for shortage of one mark shall be awarded one grace mark in such paper(s).

14.2. A candidate who fails to obtain 50% marks in aggregate at the end of six semesters for shortage of one mark shall be awarded one grace mark in the paper in which the candidate obtains the lowest mark in any of the Semester(s) in which the candidate appears last.

15. Certificate / Diploma/Degree with entry exit option:

A) Generally it will be 4 years for awarding B.F.A.D (Hons) Degree with research or B.F.A.D (Hons) Degree without research.

- 1) **4 years BFAD (Honours with research) in Fashion & apparel Design**
- 2) **4 years BFAD (Honours without research) in Fashion & apparel Design**

B) There will be another provision of awarding B.F.A.D. General (IDC) degree for candidates completing & passing full 3 years course who fails to score less than 75% in the aggregate of all 6 semesters.

- 1) **3 years BFAD General (IDC) in Fashion & Apparel Design**

C) However, there will be an exit option after completing & passing 2 years course to obtain 2 years Diploma in the subject of Fashion and Apparel Design..

1) 2 years Diploma in fashion & Apparel Design

D) Exit after completing 1 yr will be awarded a certificate in Fashion and apparel Design

However, any of such exit students from 1st yr, 2nd yr and 3 yr may come back for readmission in relevant next semester, where he/she left to complete next courses at any level of Di[ploma, degree or honours fulfilling other norms and rules of this course within 7 year total span of duration.

Moreover, Any such case of exit in any year, one 2 credit internship/field visit has to be completed additionally.

D) Identifying IDC/Research Based / Non-research Based Honours Candidates

- 1) Candidates securing 75% in aggregate (out of 1st to 6th Semester total aggregate) will be only allowed for the option of undertaking research based Hons course. However it is candidates choice that even after securing 75% marks (aggregate of 1st to 6th Semester), the student can join Non-research based Hons course. But candidates who have not secured 75% marks (aggregate of 1st to 6th Semester) will not be allowed to opt for Research based Hons course for 7th & 8th Semester and obviously they have to opt only remaining option of Non-research based hons course in 7th & 8th Semester.

However, candidates securing less than 50% marks in aggregate in total of all the 6 semesters will not be allowed to continue his or her studies in 7th and 8th semesters and will get BFAD General (IDC) Degree at the end of 6th semester, provided they have passed in each paper of all the 1st to 6th semesters.

2) **Special Option**

Special exist and Entry Option : There will be an special exit and entry option as per UGC guideline that a candidate can ask for dropping any year for different reasons informing in writing to the authority of the college that she or he can exit after 1st yr/ 2nd year / 3rd year. and may come back to complete Hons or general degree course as a re-entry from the next Semester to complete the course within total span of 7years from the date of 1st Admission in this course.

E) Board of Studies/ Board of Expert in BFAD (Hons)/ BFAD General (IDC) Degree Course will recommend to select one exam co-ordinator amongst internal Faculty members of BFAD Honours course to look after and follow up exam related work and to make liason with Chairman, BOS for university exam etc .

F)The theory and practical end semester examination will be conducted in home center for this 4 year BFAD Honours course / 3 year BFAD General (IDC) course.

16. Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) and Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) Point Grade

The below mentioned System shall be followed for the purpose of Grade Point Calculation:-

- a) Numerical Grade Point shall not be calculated in respect of a failed paper
- b) The multiplicative factors shall be 0.10 for all Grades for the purpose of calculating numerical Grade Point.

Example:

If the student secures P% , where $P \geq 30$ his/her grade point will be $[3.0 + \{(P - 30) \times 0.1\}]$ or simply $30 \times 0.10 = 3$.

If a student scores 52% in a particular paper, his/her grade point for the paper will be $(3.00 + 0.1 \times 22) = 5.20$ or simply, $52 \times 0.10 = 5.2$.

17 (a) Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA)

The Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) will be the weighted average of the numerical grade points obtained in all the papers of the given semester, where Weights refer to the Credits assigned to the concerned papers. If the Numerical Grade Points obtained by a student in different papers of a Semester are denoted by P_i and the credit of the corresponding papers are denoted by c_i , the SGPA will be $(\sum P_i \times c_i / \sum c_i)$ where $i=1$ to n , and $n=$ no. of papers in the Semester. The SGPA shall be shown in the mark sheet up to the third decimal point.

17(b) Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA)

Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) over six semesters shall be the weighted average of the six SGPA's.

$CGPA = (\sum (SGPA_j \times C_j) / \sum C_j)$ where $j = 1$ to 6 . CGPA shall be calculated and shown up to three decimal places. [SGPA_j is the SGPA of the jth Semester ($j=1$ to 6) and C_j is the total credit of jth semester used for Grade Point Calculation.

The grade of the candidate on the basis of CGPA will be as follows:

Both SGPA and CGPA will be rounded off to the third place of the decimal and will be shown as such on the mark sheet. The mark sheet issued at the end of each semester shall include the total marks obtained in each paper / module as well as the SGPA, the total marks obtained in that semester and the credit earned in the Semester concerned. The final marks sheet, on completion of six Semesters, shall include the SGPA of Six Semesters, CGPA, Letter Grade, the marks obtained, total marks and the total Credits earned.

19.. Outline of Curriculum and Credit Frame Work for BFAD Honours and BFAD General (IDC) degree course:

Category of Subjects

(A) Discipline Specific Core Course (DSCC): A course, which should compulsorily be studied by a candidate as core requirement of the Major subject.

B) Minor Course: A subject of same broad discipline to be studied by the student with lesser number of courses other than the major subject.

C) Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC): AEC courses are the courses based upon the content that leads to Knowledge enhancement in relevant subject.

D) Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC): These courses are designed to provide skill based knowledge and are aimed at providing competencies, skills etc. SEC courses are based upon skill enhancement.

E) Practical: Practicals will be there as per the demand of the course structure of the above mentioned courses, wherever required and given in the course structure.

F) Common Value Added Course (CVAC): The common value added courses are based either on the knowledge of social or human values and ethics or on the environment related subject or digitization and content related to knowledge enhancement about Indian art, embroideries, heritage textiles etc.

G) Internship: All the students are required to undertake one internship and Field visit of 2 credit at 4th Semester for 4 weeks and another internship training of 2 credit at 5th Semester for 6 to 8 weeks to gain in hand knowledge about the functioning of the relevant industry, (Garment or Retailing industry).

H) Inter Disciplinary Course (IDC) or Multi-Disciplinary Course(MDC) : All The candidates are required to study given Inter Disciplinary Course or multidisciplinary courses along with DSCC courses as a subject of same /relevant broader discipline equivalent to DSCC courses.

I) Research/ Dissertation:

1) Students obtaining CGPA equivalent to 75% marks after successful completion of all the 6 semesters may opt for Honours with research degree course in the 7th and 8th semester.

2) Students choosing a 4 years Bachelor's degree (single major in Fashion and Apparel Design with Research course) are required to take up research projects under the guidance of the allotted faculty member. The students have to complete the Research in the 7th and 8th semester of 4credits and 8 credits respectively (Total 12 credit).

A)These research Students in a group or Individually to work on a mini research topic given with Literature Review, Planning and Designing of a Research work plan and methodology and to carry out small experimental work, or desk / survey research on given topic under allotted supervisor/ Faculty member singly or jointly in 7th and 8thsemester.

B) Students have to work on given topic following a detailed research methodology under faculty or supervisors as allotted in 7th SEM , and have to continue to complete the research and has to give a presentation in a seminar with data and graphs in 8th semester final university examination..

3) Students who have not secured 75% marks in aggregate upto 1st to 6th semester in all papers have to pursue 4 year single Major Honours degree in Fashion and Apparel Design without research (**Non-Research**) and shall have to take up to 1 DSCC paper of 4 credit in 7th semester and 2 DSCC paper of each of 4 credit in 8th semester instead of Research project/ Dissertation of 8 credit.

4) Candidates who have obtained pass marks in each subject (40%) but not obtained aggregate of 50% or above for combined aggregate of marks of 1st to 6th semester will not be allowed to pursue studies in 7th and 8th semester of BFAD (Hons) degree and will be awarded BFAD General (IDC) degree course without Honours provided they have not exceeded 6years of course of study.

5) Students obtaining CGPA equivalent to 75% marks after successful completion of all the 6 semesters may also opt for Honours without research degree course in the 7th and 8th semester.

J) Term Paper- The students have to prepare samples or make documentation of various samples and prepare a report for submission during examination.
