Admission Process:

Step I: Document verification at Institute Hall, IIEST Shibpur

Step II: Issuance of admission letter (Old VC Room, Main Building, Ground Floor)

Step III: Payment of balance institute dues at UCO Bank, BESUS Branch

Step IV: Admission to JoSAA portal (Old VC Room, Main Building, Ground Floor)
Step V: Issuance of Identity Card (Office of the Dean, Main Building, First Floor)

Step VI: Hostel allotment – The Gateway Hall (1st Floor), IIEST Shibpur

Information for hostel accommodation:

The institute has limited accommodation in hostels and presently offers approximately 435 seats to male students and 128 seats to female students for the UG programme. Students admitted in any of the UG programme can apply for hostel accommodation in the prescribed form (download from institute website) and submit the duly filled in form to the The Gateway Hall (1st Floor) during admission with a photocopy of the address proof as registered in the Aadhar card / Voter identity card. Allotment of seats will be based on the distance of home from the institute.

Dues to be paid:

Institute Dues (for all students) per semester

A verified note and an student ID (SID) number will be generated if the candidate is eligible for admission and the candidate will be required to pay the balance **Institute fee** (our charges minus the fees paid in advance to JoSAA; if any).

Note the followings:

- For example, if you have paid Rs. 35,000/- to JoSAA 2019 and you are an OC candidate without any waiver you need to pay the balance amount. i.e., Rs. 36,000/- (Rs. 71000 Rs. 35,000).
- If you have already paid a fee to JoSAA 2019 in excess of the Institute fees then the
 extra amount would be refunded (you have to wait till JoSAA transfers the fee to the
 Institute: this is usually done in the Month of October-November) or adjusted in the
 subsequent semesters.
- Institute dues are to be deposited in UCO Bank BESUS branch located at the ground floor of the Science and Technology Building either in cash or by Demand Draft/Pay Order drawn in favor of 'Registrar, IIEST, Shibpur', payable at Kolkata. A candidate should collect his/her copy of the bank receipt as well as the Institutes' copy of the receipt and shall enclose the Institutes' copy of the receipt along with his/her admission form.

Hostel Dues (for Students Staying in Hostels) per Semester

The candidates who will be offered hostel need to pay the <u>hostel dues</u> of Rs. 4000*. Hostel charges of Rs. 4000/- is to be deposited in UCO Bank BESUS branch located at the ground floor of the Science and Technology Building either in Cash or by Demand Draft/Pay order drawn in favor of 'Registrar, IIEST, Shibpur', payable at Kolkata. The candidate should collect his/her copy of the bank receipt as well as the Institutes' copy of the receipt and shall enclose the Institutes' copy of the receipt together with his/her application form for admission to Hostel.

Mess Dues (for Students Staying in Hostels) at the Time of Admission

The candidates who will be offered hostel need to pay the <u>mess fees</u> (Rs. 25500/-) through online system available at the The Gateway Hall (1st Floor), IIEST Shibpur. The details of the mess dues are given below:

- Mess Entrance Fees (non refundable): Rs 3000/- per year
- Mess Establishment fee (non refundable): Rs 4000/- per semester.
- Mess Caution money (one time and refundable) Rs 1000/-
- Mess Advance: Rs 17500/- per semester (hostel mess advance will be adjusted with the mess bills at actual).

<u>The candidates are advised to bring ATM-cum-debit or</u> credit card for the payment of mess dues.

How to reach:

- IIEST, Shibpur is 6 km from Howrah Railway Station (HWH). Buses, Mini-buses, Cabs are all plying in this stretch.
- Shalimar Railway Station (SHM) is 1 km from IIEST.
- You can reach IIEST from Esplanade, the City Centre, by Buses and Cabs via RabibdraSadan and VidyasagarSetu. It is around 9 km.
- Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose International Airport (CCU) is 28 km from IIEST.
