3. Valid certificates from government authorities for the differently abled (DA) candidates.
4. Original school leaving certificate.(To be submitted within 15 days after getting admission)
5. Visva-Bharati ID Card for Permanent Staff ward.
6. Copy of online application form.
7. Medical certificate issued by a registered medical practitioner
8. Blood group report of the candidate.
9. Three Passport size Photograph.

Documents for Neighborhood candidates:

1. Photocopy of Parents' ration card.
2. Photocopy of candidate's ration card.
3. Photocopy of parents' Voter card issued by the Election Commission of India .

A set of photocopies of relevant documents to be attested by the guardian will have to be submitted at the time of admission.

1. Admission to Pre-Primary: 1st Year, Mrinalini Ananda Pathshala, Patha Bhavana, Visva Bharati

Online applications are invited for admission to Mrinalini Ananda Pathshala: Pre-Primary 1st Year from different categories of candidates, such as, Open Category (OC), Alumni-wards (AW), Economically Weaker Section (EWS) Category and Staff-wards (SW) for the year 2021.

Who can apply:

- **Open Category (OC):** Candidates who do not belong to either Staff-Ward or Alumni Ward category.
- **Alumni Ward (AW):** Wards of the members of the Alumni Association
- **Staff-Ward (SW):** Wards of the permanent staff-members of Visva-Bharati
- **EWS:** Candidates who belong to economically weaker section of the society.

Neighbourhood Candidates: In case of Open Category and Alumni Wards, 20% of total seats are reserved for Neighbourhood candidates residing within the radius of 1 km of Patha-Bhavana Office, Visva-Bharati, and maintaining Government reservation rules.

4. Admission of Staff Wards in Other Classes of Patha-Bhavana, Visva Bharati

The wards of permanent staff members, who did not apply on earlier occasions, can also apply to a class appropriate to his or her age from Pre-Primary-2nd Year, Mrinalini Ananda Pathshala to Class-VIII, provided the candidates fulfill all other criteria.

5. Admission of Foreign Students to Patha-Bhavana, Visva Bharati

15% of total number of seats of class is reserved for foreign students on supernumerary basis.

Documents to be produced at the time of Admission:

- a) 'Birth Registration Certificate' issued by competent Government authority. (Form No. 9 or Form No. 5).
- b) Certificate from appropriate Government authorities in case of SC/ST/OBC/EWS candidates (either of candidate or father only).
- c) Valid certificate from government authorities for the differently abled (Divyangana) candidates.
- d) Progress Report/Mark Sheet of the last examination passed for Class I & II.
- e) Alumni ID Card or Letter of Membership from Visva-Bharati for Alumni-Ward.
- f) Visva-Bharati Staff ID Card for Permanent Staff wards.
- g) Medical Certificate from a Registered Medical Practitioner.
- h) Blood Group Certificate.
- i) Copy of online application form.
- j) Three passport Size photographs.

Documents for Neighbourhood candidates:

1. Photocopy of Parents' ration card.
 2. Photocopy of candidate's ration card.
 3. Photocopy of parents' voter card issued by the Election Commission of India.
- A set of photocopies of relevant documents to be attested by the guardian will have to be submitted at the time of admission.
 - School Leaving Certificate from the previous School. (to be submitted within 15 days after getting admission)
 - **Incomplete applications will be rejected. Request for any sort of addition or alteration in the application form after submission will not be entertained.**

General Guidelines

Reservation: - As per Govt. of India reservation rules. Only 'non-creamy layer' OBC candidates as per 'Central list of OBC' ([http:// www.ncbc.nic.in/user_panel/centralliststateview.aspx](http://www.ncbc.nic.in/user_panel/centralliststateview.aspx)) shall get the benefit of reservation in admission.

EWS: Economically Weaker Sections (EWS)

[UGC (MHRD) Order F.No.81-1/2019 (CU) dated 18th January, 2019] CRITERIA OF INCOME & ASSETS:

- a. Candidates who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs and whose family has gross annual income below Rs.8.00 lakh (Rupees eight lakh) only are to be identified as EWSs for benefit of reservation. Income shall also include income from all sources i.e., salary, agriculture, business, profession, etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application. Further candidates whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of the family income:
 - 5 acres of agricultural land and above;
 - Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft and above;
 - Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;
 - Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities.
- b. The property held by a "Family" in different location or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status.
- c. The term "Family" for the purpose will include the person who seeks benefits of reservation, his/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years.

Income and Asset certificate issuing Authority and Verification of certificate:

- a. The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority. The Income and Asset certificate issued by any one of the following authorities in the prescribed format only be accepted as proof of candidate's claim as belonging to EWS:
District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate /Collector/ Deputy Commissioner/ Additional Deputy Commissioner/1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Taluka Magistrate/ Executive Magistrate/Extra Assistant Commissioner; Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate; Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar and Sub-Divisional Officer or the area where the candidate and/or his family normally resides.
- b. The officers who issue the certificate would do the same after carefully verifying all relevant documents following due process as prescribed by the respective state/UT.

c. The crucial date for submitting income and asset certificate by the candidate may be treated as the closing date for receipt of application.
