- **In case of tie in Merit List of Honours, candidate securing higher subject marks obtained in higher secondary level examination will be given more merit.**

### **Guidelines for Subject Choice (B.A and B.Sc General)**

- A student has to choose two subjects as **core courses (CC)** & one subject for **generic elective (GE)**.
- The subjects chosen as **CC** will be studied in all **6 semesters**
- The subject chosen as **GE** will be studied only in Semester **I & II**
- For the language core course **(LCC 1) English** is compulsory in semester **III & V**.
- A student has to choose one subject as **LCC 2** to be studied in semester **IV & VI** from the following options:  
**A) Bengali B) Hindi C) Alternative English**
- A student opting **B.Sc general course** has to choose 3 subjects as **core courses (CC)** to be studied in all 6 semesters.

**In case of tie in Merit List of General, candidate securing higher aggregate marks obtained in higher secondary level examination will be given more merit.**
